- PAUS registered non-fullblood animals may be dual registered with NAPA in the Naturalean Registry for the fee of \$15. Animals must have DNA test verification that they are (homozygous) 2-copy for myostatin, and the NAPA Registrar accepts test results from Scidera, Igenity, or GenMark Labs. Registry application forms can be printed off from the Printable Forms page at www.piedmontese.org, completed and mailed with fees to the NAPA Registrar together with a copy of the PAUS papers and DNA test verification results. Dual-registry applications should be submitted by no later than Jan. 15th in order to be complete by the Show entry deadline.
 - Fullblood animals registered with PAUS or the Canadian Piedmontese Assoc. (CPA) are eligible to show provided that they would meet NAPA standards of Fullblood registry.
 - Cattle must be in place by NOON on Thursday March 15, 2012.
