Nominations must include:

- a detailed report of the activities and achievements of the animal or person, and must clearly demonstrate their positive impact on the North American Piedmontese industry. In the case of cattle, this impact does not necessarily have to be from the show ring. (Sires of award winning carcass competition or steer performance test offspring, for example.)
- contact information for the nominee or their family, if known; in the case of nominated cattle, please include a copy of the registration papers, if possible.

Please include as many photographs as possible with this nomination form.

The Directors of the North American Piedmontese Association will review each submission that is received by October 15. The NAPA Board shall select the most worthy animal(s) and or person(s) in any given year for induction in to the Piedmontese Hall of Fame, to be announced the following January. However, it is not mandatory that the Board select any one or more of the nominees in any given year.

Hall of Fame cattle are listed with the “breeder” (owner of the dam at the time of the mating that produced the resulting animal). The “breeder” is the creator of the animal. There may have been numerous owners of these cattle, even from birth in the case of embryos. The listings will also show the last known owner of the animal. Details of owners who may have promoted the animal will be given in the Hall of Fame stories posted on the website at www.piedmontese.org , whenever possible.
