INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION FORMS (NAPA)

1. The tattoo year letter for 2007 is T. Animal tattoo year letter MUST correspond to the year the animal was BORN.
 2. Forms must be filled in ink, or typewritten.
 3. The signature of the person owning the animal at time of birth must appear at the top of each page.
 4. Mail the forms directly to CLRC. All fees must accompany the applications, or they will not be processed until the fees are received.
 5. **Name of Calf** to be not longer than 30 characters and spaces.
 6. **AI or ET.** If sired by AI – check the box; If calf is the result of Embryo Transfer, check the box and attach ET documents. [DNA parentage verification may be required.]
 7. **Calf Tattoo-** the animal's permanent ID in the ear, with your Herd Prefix, a number designation for the individual, and the Year Letter, showing year of birth. If tattoo is in the Right Ear, complete that area, or if in the Left Ear complete that area.
 8. **Birth date** - the day/month/year the calf was born.
 9. **Sex** - either "M" for male, or "F" for female.
 10. In the section **TWIN**, please simply check the box if the animal is a twin - even if both do not survive, and indicate the sex of the twin.
 11. **CE** (Calving Ease) use the following codes: U=unassisted delivery; E=easy, hand assisted delivery, H=hard, hand or mechanical delivery, M=malpresentation, assisted, and S= surgical, caesarian section birth.
 12. **Birth Weight:** an accurate weight taken within 24 hours of birth. If you cannot weigh PLEASE do not guess! Simply leave the section blank.
 13. Note: in all cases, the **DAM** means the genetic dam, not the recipient cow in the case of Embryo Transfer. The genetic dam is the cow who is the dam of the animal that you wish to register.
 14. **MYOSTATIN** – mandatory DNA Myostatin results must be available prior to registry or recordation. [0-copy animals will not be registered or recorded; 1-copy animals will be RECORDED.]
 15. **DNA** – write the DNA Test Case # in this box if you have conducted a DNA Parentage Test and/or Permanent Record for the applicant animal. **Parentage Verification for sire, or dam, or sire & dam, or “un-verified” will be marked on the certificate.**
 16. **Sire** - the sire of the calf; either natural service, AI, or ET.
 17. **Service Information:** the date the cow was bred. There are 3 possibilities: a) the cow was AI bred - **give the date of service.** b) The cow was exposed to a natural service sire(s) - if exposed to multiple bulls a DNA parentage test will be needed, **fill in the form with the dates beginning to end of exposure, for each bull.** c) The cow was AI bred and exposed to a natural service sire(s) - **please report the AI date, and all dates of exposure. If you do not have enough space, please attach an added sheet.**
 18. **COLOR** – Fullbloods are either fawn or grey/white; Naturalean – indicate color of calf.
 19. **HORNED, SCURRED, POLLED** – Fullbloods are genetically Horned so no options are given on the application; Naturalean – indicate one choice, either Horned, Scurred or Polled. (De-horned cattle are still genetically HORNED)
